**Resolved:** Non for profit groups will all have a 50% discount for hire of the Community Centre, amended to 45% by Cllr Oldfield and Cllr Evans, to be looked at again in 6 months - 8 in favour

**Proposed: Cllr Haigh, Seconded: Cllr K Hesketh**

**Resolved:** The bar will be available for hire – 6 in favour, 5 abstentions – vote carried

**Proposed: Cllr Haigh, Seconded Cllr Evans**

**Resolved:** the bar should be available for hire at a flat rate of £7 per hour

*Different discussions took place around the table with people speaking over each other and disputes. The Chair called the meeting to order. Cllr K Hesketh said we had already voted on this. The Clerk clarified “this is for the price of the bar hire. £7 per hour for the hire of the Bar”. A vote then took place on this motion, incorrectly and unintentionally different from the original proposal. 7 in favour, 1 abstention.*

This was not challenged during the meeting.

The Clerk was instructed to find out from the insurers about the use of deep fat fryers.

Bar stock was deferred for the next meeting
