Re: Land to the rear of Mayfield Avenue, South Killingholme, DN40 3DF

The application states "A retrospective planning application at the above-mentioned address has been submitted via Planning Portal for 'the change of use of land for residential mobile homes and dayroom.'

The applicant seeks planning permission for one residential pitch to meet a recognised and personal need, for such facilities in the area to support a gypsy lifestyle.

Following a site visit and consultation with the client, the site layout has been determined to best meet the applicant's requirements and although it has been withdrawn by the Government, in the absence of any replacement document, the pitch has been designed with reference to the standards that were defined in 'Designing Gypsy and Travellers Sites – A Good Practice Guide (2008)'.

The proposed caravans will conform to the definition within Section 29(1) of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 and Section 13(1) of the Caravan Sites Act 1968, and therefore, plans and elevations of individual units are not required."
